- Don't mix personal passwords with business passwords.
- Don't enter your user name and password on a website from an unexpected email or social media link.







- Do consider using a password manager.
- Do create unique patterns and use special characters and numbers.
- Do change default passwords.
- Do update passwords on important accounts yearly.
